ANNUAL REPORT 2023

Thankfully, 2022 witnessed something of a return to normality even if we did have to celebrate the 'New Year' three months late!

- The AGM went ahead as planned on the 8th March; as always, business followed by a much appreciated supper arranged by Rosemary Foster. At this meeting we welcomed for the first time both Kate Finch and Rita Woodhead. Twenty eight twinners were present.
- The New Year Drinks & Nibbles party eventually went ahead after being postponed a couple of times until, finally, we got together at 'Bunchfield' on Sunday 3rd April. Spring was very much in the air, the impact of Covid was receding and we were all so pleased to be able to meet up again. The quality of the finger food provided by members was at its usual high standard.
- 31st Anniversary of our being twinned with Horb was celebrated in some style and coincided with our late Queen Elizabeth's Platinum Jubilee. We were particularly pleased to welcome the Oberbürgermeister of Horb and his wife, Peter and Janet Rosenberger, along with their three children.
- The BBQ Summer Social (Sat 16th Jul) at 'Bunchfield' was an extremely happy occasion on a gloriously sunny day, when we found ourselves 'competing' for shade! The pétanque match was enthusiastically contested and the excellent food provided by the members and cooked by Sylvia + was devoured with much relish (pun intended). It was a real pleasure to see at least six totally new guests at this event brought by members. We very much want this to be a feature of all future summer social BBQs and encourage existing members to be thinking who they can invite this year.
